The building was abuzz all day with bikes coming in and out. On Friday with the severe weather approaching there was a mad dash of owners trying to get bikes into the building that was already pretty full. Many had to be sent to the big building where the golf carts were kept next to vendor registration. But with the weather a lot of neat old bikes that normally do not get put in the building

ended up in there for at least a night for all to enjoy. We had quite a few of the cannonball riders put their exquisite machines in for us all to ponder the thoughts of driving over three thousand miles on one of these machines.

Sunday, judging day was a busy one. After a hot buffet breakfast the judges were ready to get to work. They judged a total of 65 bikes and had quite a variety to keep them going too.

Judged at the meet this year were 32 Harley Davidsons, 9 Hondas, 4 Indians, 4 BMW's, 3 Triumphs, 2 BSA's, 2 Nortons, 2 Kawasakis and one of each Cyrus, Excelsior, Gina, Matchless, Moto Guzzi, Motobi, Scott and Suzuki. The awards were given out and everyone was out of the building by I or so. Congratulations to Hollie Swain who deservingly won the Smitty Award this year. Thanks Hollie for all your hard work.

We had a contest in the building this year. There were pictures of 6 bikes. Some not well know. A Iver Jefferson, Appache, Norton, BSA, Brough Superior and Excelsior.
